

Kahoona

Directions for use

Apply evenly to pre-soaked soil around the drip line of the plant, avoiding contact with foliage or flowers. Water again well. Apply after signs of new season growth and thereafter every 8-10 weeks throughout the growing season - Spring to Autumn. In Winter apply Seamungus.

Established potted plants:

15g per 150mm size pot then at 5g per 25mm pot size increase.
